Policy 133: Service Animals Policy

Chapter: 1 – College Organization and Administration

Section: B – Equal Education and Employment Opportunities

Date: 3/21/2018

Purpose: The College is committed to providing members of the college community with disabilities equal access to programs, services and physical facilities. It is acknowledged that some members of the community with disabilities may require the use of Service Animals while at the college. Below are guidelines concerning the appropriate use of and protocols associated with Service Animals. The College reserves the right to amend these guidelines as needed, with or without prior notice.

Policy: In compliance with applicable law, the College generally allows service animals in its buildings, classrooms, meetings, dining area, recreational facilities, activities and events when the animal is accompanied by an individual with a disability who indicates the service animal is trained to provide, and does provide, a specific service to them that is directly related to their disability.
