Permit to Carry Course

Course Description

This class is designed for those wanting to secure their Minnesota Permit to Carry license. Students learn firearm safety, safe carry considerations, and the legal implications of your permit to carry licensing.

This 7-hour class is unique from other Permit to Carry courses. It incorporates basic handgun information. This course will cover safety, handling, operation, storage and maintenance of handgun platforms, including revolvers and semiautomatic pistols. Students will gain knowledge in basic shooting fundamentals and confidence in safely using their firearms.

A range qualification is part of the course. Students will receive a certificate upon successful completion. This class is conducted by a firearms instructor who is certified by the USCCA.

Permit to Carry Renewal Course

Course Description

This course is designed for a person who is already in possession of a Permit to Carry (PTC) and is looking to renew their current or recently expired MN Permit to Carry certification. Permits must be renewed every 5 years. This course will refresh and update the permitted individual on MN laws pertaining to carrying a firearm, safe handling, firearm selection, situational awareness, and best practices while carrying a firearm.

Additional Information for both the Initial Permit to Carry Course & the Renewal Course

- Class Cost includes Range Fees
- It is preferred that students bring their own handgun and ammunition. Please note, the range will not accept aluminum case ammunition. Students can either bring their own gun and ammo or purchase the gun rental and ammo charge at the range (approximately \$25.00/student)

Please note ammunition charges may fluctuate

Requirements for Initial & Renewal Courses

- Students must attend class in its entirety
 - Students must demonstrate safe gun handling & use
 - Students must pass a live fire qualification (80% or better)
 - Students must bring the following to class:
 - Eye & Ear protection
 - Handgun & 100 rounds of ammunition
 - Students must be 20+ years old
- **Please note: Students that are 20 years old may participate as long as it is less than 1 year prior to their 21st birthday***
- Students must abide by all laws regarding CCW licensure
 - Students must provide a copy of their drivers license prior to attending class
