


Career Focus

Emergency Medical Services

ACADEMY

EMTs are a critical link between the scene of an emergency and the health care system. Learn the basic knowledge and skills necessary to stabilize and safely transport patients ranging from non-emergency and routine medical transports to life-threatening emergencies.

Pine Pathways

The college credit earned through the EMS Academy satisfy the requirements of PTCC's EMT certificate, and EMT 1725 and EMT 1735 will transfer into PTCC's Emergency Medical Services Professional certificate.

Employment Outlook

Employment of emergency medical technicians (EMTs) and paramedics is projected to grow 6 percent from 2019 to 2029, faster than the average for all occupations. Median annual wage was \$35,400 in May 2019.

PINE ACADEMIES

Pine Technical and Community College (PTCC) offers high school students the opportunity to participate in several different career and technical education (CTE) academy programs called Pine Academies. Pine Academies are a series of courses focused on specific careers or areas of interest and are designed to give students a jump start on their college education and explore future career options. Credits earned in academy courses count towards a student's high school diploma, their future college degree, and are easily transferred to other colleges and universities.

Pine Academies are offered at local high schools and via PTCC's Interactive Television (ITV) program. Select academies are offered at each location, so make sure to talk with your high school counselor about availability at your school.

American Sign Language ACADEMY



The **American Sign Language Academy** provides you with the foundational knowledge and skills of the American Sign Language (ASL). The academy courses provide a basic foundation for entry into a career in a deafness-related field.

Pine Pathways

The college credit earned through the American Sign Language Academy will transfer into PTCC's American Sign Language Studies certificate and the Associate of Arts degree.

Employment Outlook

Employment of interpreters and translators is projected to grow 20% by 2029, much faster than the average for all occupations. Median annual wage was \$51,830 in May 2019.

Automotive ACADEMY



In the **Automotive Academy**, you will experience a unique, hands-on learning opportunity and work side-by-side with industry-certified technicians to develop high tech skills used in today's automotive repair and technology fields. The academy prepares you with the technical knowledge and skills to repair, service, and maintain all types of automobiles.

Pine Pathways

The college credit earned through the Automotive Academy will transfer into PTCC's Automotive Technology certificate, diploma, and AAS degrees.

Employment Outlook

Employment of automotive service technicians and mechanics is projected to decline 4% by 2029, however, job opportunities for qualified jobseekers should be very good. Median annual wage was \$42,090 in May 2019.

Early Childhood Education ACADEMY



The increasing need for educated early care and education caregivers can lead to a rewarding and challenging career in child care centers, pre-schools, early childhood education, and many other settings.

The **Early Childhood Education Academy** prepares you for this in-demand field through four introductory courses.


Pine Pathways

Employment Outlook

Employment of childcare workers is projected to grow 2% by 2029. Median hourly wage was \$11.65 in May 2019.

Marketing or Management? Entrepreneur or CEO? Business-related fields are among the most popular college majors. In the **Business Academy**, you will learn foundational business skills including business computer applications, business communications, conflict resolution, team building, and how to utilize business information systems.


Pine Pathways

The college credit earned through the Business Academy transfers into PTCC's Business Essentials certificate, Business Administration diploma, Business Transfer Pathway AS, and the Management Information Systems diploma and AAS degrees.

Employment Outlook

Employment in business and financial operations, and management occupations is projected to grow 5% by 2029. Median annual wage for business and financial occupations was \$69,820, and management occupations \$105,660 in May 2019.

Healthcare ACADEMY



In the **Healthcare Academy** you will gain the foundational knowledge and skills necessary to work with patients or clients in healthcare, assisted living, or senior living atmospheres.

These courses prepare students for the Nursing Assistant Test-Out Exam.

Pine Pathways

The college credit earned through the Healthcare Academy will transfer into PTCC's Nursing Assistant and Medication Aide certificate, Practical Nursing diploma, and the Associate Degree Nursing (RN) degree.

Employment Outlook

Employment in healthcare occupations is expected to grow 15% by 2029. Median annual wage for healthcare practitioners and technical occupations was \$68,190 in May 2019.

Information Technology ACADEMY

Information technology is part of our everyday lives. Careers in this field will continue to grow exponentially. The **Information Technology Academy** exposes students to this exciting industry through introductory coursework in PC hardware and software support.

These courses prepare students for the CompTIA A+ certification.

The college credit earned through the Information Technology Academy will transfer into PTCC's Cyber Security AAS and Network Administration AAS degrees.

Employment Outlook

Employment in computer and information technology occupations is expected to grow 11% by 2029. Median annual wage for computer and information technology occupations was \$88,240 in May 2019.
