Chapter: 1 – College Organization

Date: 10/4/2018

Policy: It is the objective of the college to comply with provisions of the Code of Ethics for employees in the Executive Branch (Minnesota Statute 43A.380 and Minnesota State Board Procedure 1.C.01).

Employees will maintain high standards of conduct while on the job and avoid conduct or activity that will appear to:

- conflict with employment
- result in the use of an employee's position for private or personal gain
- interfere with an employee's objectivity
- lower the public's confidence in the college's integrity
