Students that have been affected by the coronavirus may apply for the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) emergency funds by completing the Fall 2021 ARPA Emergency Aid—Balance Due Application. Students can request up to \$1000 in additional emergency assistance to cover past balance due balance. Funding is not guaranteed.
