AD Prerequisites and Liberal Arts Courses

"C" or higher AND cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher in the following courses:

- 2. BIOL 1250 General Biology, 4 cr. Prerequisite: Next-Gen Accuplacer Arithmetic 250+ or QAS 230+ and Next-Gen Accuplacer Reading 250+
3. BIOL 1255 Microbiology, 3 cr. Prerequisite: BIOL 1250
4. BIOL 1260 Anatomy & Physiology I, 4 cr. Prerequisite: BIOL 1250
5. BIOL 1270 Anatomy & Physiology II, 4 cr. Prerequisite: BIOL 1260
6. ENGL 1276 College Composition, 4 cr. Prerequisite: Accuplacer Reading 250+
7. PHIL 1220 Human Ethics, 3 cr. Prerequisite: Accuplacer Reading 250+
8. PSYC 1200 Intro to Psychology, 3 cr. Prerequisite: Accuplacer Reading 250+ OR PSYC 1210 General Psychology, 4 cr. Prerequisite: Accuplacer Reading 250+
9. PSYC 1250 Lifespan Development, 3 cr. Prerequisite: PSYC 1200 or PSYC 1210

- 10. Current LPN license in MN or WI by July 15, 2023
11. Highly Recommended: Attend PTCC Nursing Programs/Healthcare Programs Information Session
12. Passing of AD entrance examination: ATI TEAS (Reading, Math, Science, English and Language Usage). Cut score: 68
o Official test scores must be received by the application deadline date
o TEAS scores are valid for up to 18 months from the time of application
13. Completion of Associate Degree Nursing application

Additional Requirements Upon Acceptance

- 14. *Immunizations (before submitting documents, review them to ensure all immunizations are listed)
o Typically given as a child: Measles/Mumps/Rubella, Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis, Varicella (Chicken Pox)—depends upon age
o Additional: Tuberculosis, Influenza, Hepatitis B, COVID
15. *Background study
All students must have a cleared background study
16. *Current Healthcare Professional CPR
o American Heart Association CPR for Healthcare Provider (BLS Provider) is the only accepted CPR. Must have hands-on skills test-out.
17. 1 or 2 General Education elective credits (depending on PSYC course taken) from any MN Transfer Curriculum Goal area and is not a program prerequisite course.

*Proof of completion is due 2-3 weeks prior to the start of the semester. See the application timeline for details.
