Prerequisite: Next-Gen Accuplacer Arithmetic 250+ or QAS 230+ and Next-Gen Accuplacer Reading 250+
OR: In substitution of BIOL 1240, ALL 3 of the following courses or their equivalents: BIOL 1250, and BIOL 1260, and BIOL 1270
- _____3. ENGL 1276 College Composition, 4 cr.
Prerequisite: Next-Gen Accuplacer Reading 250+
- _____4. HPPC 1002 Medical Terminology, 1 cr.
-Valid for 5 years
- _____5. HPPC 1004 Pharmacology, 1 cr.
-Valid for 5 years
- _____6. HPPC 1000 Medical Dosages, 1 cr.
-Valid for 5 years
- _____7. Must be in good standing on the MN or WI State Nursing Assistant Registry by Jan. 1 (for spring application), or by July 15 (for fall application).
- _____8. **Highly Recommended:** Attend PTCC Nursing Programs/Healthcare Programs Information Session

- _____9. Passing of PN entrance examination: ATI TEAS (Reading, Math, Science, English and Language Usage). Cut score: 53
- Official test scores must be received by the application deadline date
 - TEAS scores are valid for up to 18 months from the time of application

Additional Requirements Upon Acceptance

- _____11. ***Immunizations** (before submitting documents, review them to ensure all immunizations are listed)
- Typically given as a child: Measles/Mumps/Rubella, Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis, Varicella (Chicken Pox)—depends upon age
 - Additional: Tuberculosis, Influenza, Hepatitis B, COVID
- _____12. ***Background study**
All students must have a cleared background study
- _____13. ***Current Healthcare Professional CPR**
- American Heart Association CPR for Healthcare Provider (BLS provider) is the only accepted CPR. Must have hands-on skills test-out.
- *Proof of completion is due 2-3 weeks prior to the start of the semester you enter the program. See application for details.**
