The Nursing Mobility program expands upon the foundational knowledge and skills of Licensed Practical Nurses (LPNs) who want to pursue an Associate of Science (A.S.) Degree in Nursing. The curriculum prepares nurses to practice professionalism, leadership, clinical reasoning, and adherence to the Nursing Code of Ethics. With an A.S. in Nursing, students are eligible to apply to take the National Council Licensure Exam for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN). This program provides a pathway for students who wish to pursue academic advancement or seek employment in a wide variety of healthcare settings.

Application to AD Nursing Program

Students must apply to the Associate Degree Program for the Fall 2023 start.

At the time of application students must have:

- Completed all prerequisite courses by the end of spring semester 2023, with a grade of "C" or better, and a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Be currently licensed as a Practical Nurse (LPN) by July 15.
- Have taken the ATI TEAS exam within the last 18 months with an overall composite score of 68 or higher.
