



High School students who complete American Sign Language I and American Sign Language II with Dakota Shearer at Pine City High School or via Interactive Television (ITV) are eligible to articulate their high school credits to Pine Technical and Community College (PTCC) in order to continue on to take American Sign Language III (LASL 2270) and American Sign Language IV (LASL 2275) at PTCC.

In order to have high school credits articulated and to register for LASL 2270 and LASL 2275 at PTCC, a student must complete the following:

1. Earn a final course grade of A, B, or C in each articulated course ASL I (6551a-6551b) and ASL II (6552a-6552b)
2. Enroll at PTCC within two years of high school graduation
3. Complete the Student Articulation Form
4. Submit official high school transcripts

Once all of the items listed above are complete, and the student successfully completes ASL 2270 and ASL 2275, the student will receive a Pass "P" grade on their official PTCC record.
