PTCC WINS "DEMOCRACY CUP" FOR 2-YEAR PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS

Minnesota's Democracy Cup is the statewide collegiate voter turnout competition. Every two years, campuses across Minnesota compete against one another to achieve the highest percentage of voting of those eligible to vote. In 2022, PTCC achieved the highest voter turnout with 48.3% of eligible students voting.

Did you know PTCC is an Ability to Benefit institution? AtB is a federal financial program that allows students without a high school diploma (or an equivalent like a GED or home school diploma) to qualify for financial aid if they prove they have the ability to benefit from a college education. Financial aid can help pay for tuition, books, fees and other educational expenses for college-level classes.

PTCC partners with <u>St. Croix River</u> <u>Education District (SCRED)</u> and Adult Basic Education to help students earn their high school equivalency diploma (GED/Adult Diploma), while providing additional support to students enrolled in an eligible career program at PTCC.
