PSEO Eligible Career & Technical Education Courses for 10th Graders

PSEO students in 10th grade will be allowed to register for one Career and Technical Education (CTE) course during their first semester (depending on course requirements). If they are successful (C or higher) in their first course, they can register for more in their second semester.
