

TUITION & FEE-FREE PATHWAY

NORTH STAR PROMISE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The North Star Promise (NSP) Scholarship program creates a tuition and fee-free pathway to higher education for eligible Minnesota residents at eligible institutions as a “last-dollar” program by covering the balance of tuition and fees remaining after other scholarships, grants, stipends and tuition waivers have been applied.

Eligibility:

- Minnesota resident
- Have a family Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) as reported on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or Minnesota Dream Act Application below \$80,000
- Not be in default on a state or federal student loan
- Be enrolled taking at least one credit
- Meet Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) standards
- Have not already earned a baccalaureate degree
- Applies to all PTCC programs

What is the application process:

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or Minnesota Dream Act Application
- There is no additional application beyond FAFSA or Minnesota Dream Act Application. PTCC will assess your eligibility on a term-by-term basis and award the North Star Promise Scholarship if eligible

Eligible students are able to receive one of the following scholarships each year.

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

\$2,500 scholarship

Eligibility:

- Must be enrolled (each semester in 9 or more credits) in one of the following high-growth/high-demand areas of study: Advanced Manufacturing, Automotive Technology, Construction, Early Childhood Education, Health Sciences, or Information Technology.
- Minnesota resident

KICK START

Supports two years of tuition and up to \$1,000 for required books, tools, and supplies

Eligibility:

- Graduate from Chisago, Isanti, Kanabec, or Pine County (Minnesota); Isle High School; Burnett County (Wisconsin); or a homeschool student residing within these areas
- Attend PTCC the semester following high school graduation
- Complete the FAFSA, or Minnesota Dream Act, and applicable state grant applications, prior to the start of the semester
- Enroll in a minimum of 12 credits per semester
- Applies to all PTCC programs
- Have a family Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) as reported on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or Minnesota Dream Act Application below \$80,000

FRANSEN FAMILY FOUNDATION

Supports two years of tuition and up to \$1,000 for required books, tools, and supplies

Eligibility:

- Graduate from Ada-Borup West, Braham, Clinton-Graceville-Beardeley, Ely, Pine City, Rush City, Warren-Alvarado-Oslo, or Waterville-Elysian-Morristown High Schools in Minnesota, or Frederic and Luck High Schools in Wisconsin; or a homeschool student residing within these areas
- Attend PTCC the semester following high school graduation
- Complete the FAFSA, or Minnesota Dream Act, and applicable state grant applications, prior to the start of the semester
- Enroll in a minimum of 12 credits per semester
- Applies to all PTCC programs, with the exception of Associate of Arts degree

BRIDGING THE DREAM

Up to a \$1,250 scholarship for full-time students, or \$750 scholarship for part-time students

Eligibility:

- New or returning students registered for full time (minimum 12 credits) or part time (minimum 6 credits)
- Applies to all PTCC programs
