



Program Requirements

- **Tuition:** visit pine.edu/tuition-fees
- **Books/Software:** \$1,000. Visit pine.edu/campus-store for details.
- **Laptop:** Standard version required. Learn more at pine.edu/supplies
 - MacBooks and Google Chromebooks are not recommended due to compatibility issues with products used in the Nursing Program courses.
- **Tools/Supplies:** See details below.
- **Uniform:** Required. Scrubs are required, including tops, pants, shoes, and jackets. Uniforms may be purchased through PTCC Campus Store or from an approved vendor. Details will be shared at mandatory orientation session for Nursing students. Approx. cost is \$250.
- **Federal Background Study:** \$55
