The Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC) is a statewide program that completes general education requirements and prepares you to transfer to a four-year Minnesota college or university. When finished as part of an associate degree, the MnTC transfers as a complete package and fulfills the first two years of general education at participating institutions.

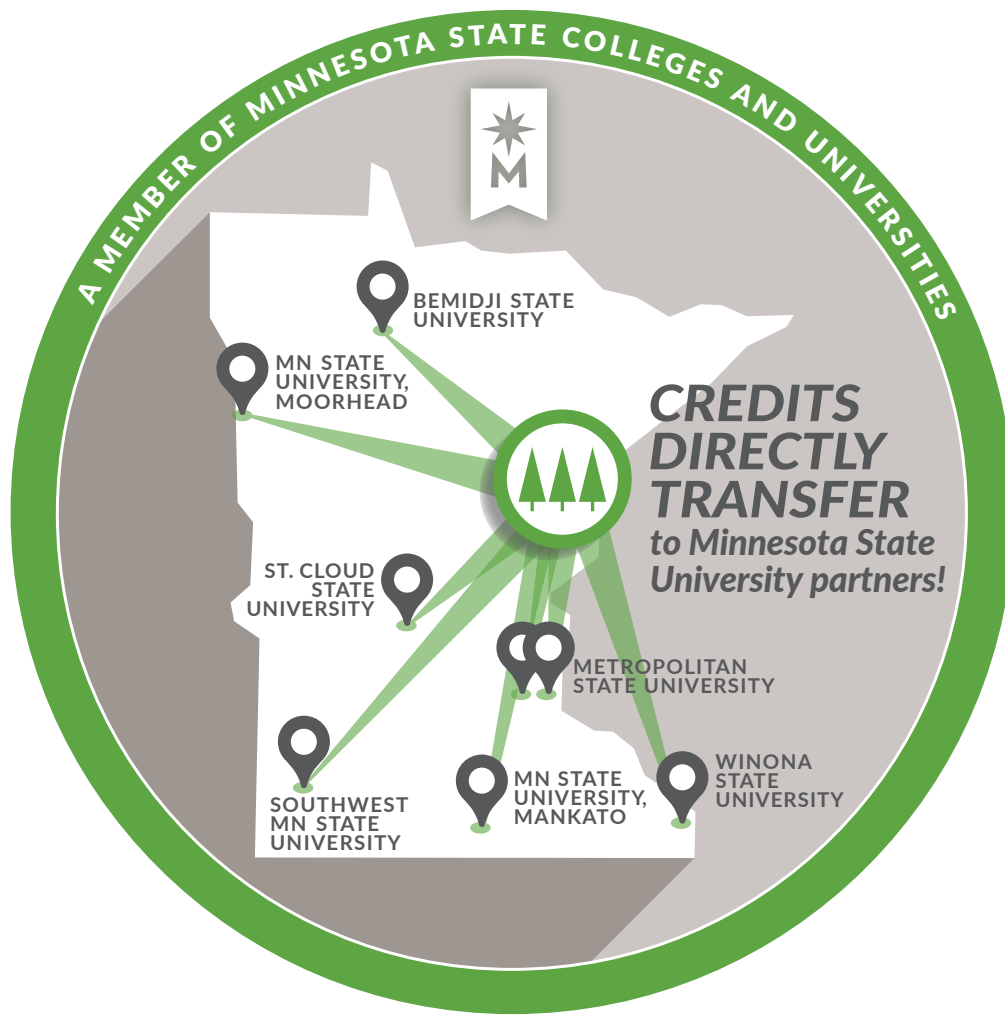
