Explore Automation, Manufacturing and Welding: Innovate and Create

Join us for a hands-on experience where creativity meets real-world skills. In this session, students will design and build their own camp stove while exploring the fundamentals of welding, automation, and fabrication.

After completing your build, you'll put your stove to the test during a 4–6 hour canoe trip on the scenic St. Croix River. Along the way, you'll prepare a shore lunch using your custom-built equipment—combining technical skills, teamwork, and the outdoors into one unforgettable experience.

Explore Construction: Craft Your Canoe Paddle

Dive into the world of construction by designing and building your very own canoe paddle! Using real tools and materials, you'll learn essential carpentry and craftsmanship skills while creating a paddle that's uniquely yours. The highlight of the week? Testing your creation during a 4-6 hour canoe trip down the scenic St. Croix River on Thursday.
