



Program Requirements

- **Books/software:** Visit pine.edu/campus-store for details
- **Laptop:** Not Required. Students are not required to own a personal laptop but must have access to a computer that meets the necessary specifications to complete coursework. Learn more at pine.edu/supplies
- **Tools/supplies:** See details below
- **Uniform:** Required. Students in the EMS program at PTCC are required to wear a professional uniform that includes a white button-down shirt, black EMS or plain black khaki-style pants, and black boots. A black jacket may be worn, but it must not have any graphics or logos unless they are PTCC-specific. All uniform items should be clean, well-maintained, and properly fitted to ensure a professional appearance. Approx. cost is \$200.

Notes

Students in the EMS program should be aware that clinical site requirements for background checks may vary. While a standard background check is part of the program’s onboarding process, some clinical sites may require additional or more in-depth background screenings.

These requirements are determined by the clinical site, not the college, and may include an associated cost that the student will be responsible for. Students are encouraged to stay informed about the specific requirements for their assigned clinical site and be prepared to complete any additional steps as needed.

Some tools and supplies may be available for purchase at the campus store. If you have financial aid funds available, you may use financial aid for these items, provided the purchases are made through the campus store.

If your program requires a specific laptop, you may also use financial aid to purchase it through the campus store. However, laptops do not need to be purchased through the campus store—you may choose to buy from another retailer. If purchasing a laptop elsewhere, it is the student’s responsibility to carefully review the required specifications for their specific program to ensure compatibility.
