Notes

Riflesmithing and Barreling and Chambering: Students are required to provide a bolt action rifle that will be re-barreled and customized, 1 firearm can be used for both classes as well as Stockmaking and Refinishing.

Stockmaking and Refinishing: Additional parts and accessories will also need to be purchased at time of these classes. See course instructor or syllabus for current lists and details.

Shotgunsmithing: Students are required to provide a shotgun that will be modified and customized, the firearm can be used for stockmaking and refinishing. Additional parts and accessories will also need to be purchased at time of these classes. See course instructor or syllabus for current lists and details.

Pistolsmithing: Students are required to provide a 1911 style pistol that will be modified and customized. This pistol can also be used for refinishing and handgun classes. Additional parts and accessories will also need to be purchased at time of these classes. See course instructor or syllabus for current lists and details.

Gunsmithing Capstone: Students are required to provide a firearm of their choice, with instructor permission, to be used in a customization or restoration project. Examples of capstone course firearms may include, but are not limited to, custom rifle, shotgun, handgun, double rifle, or muzzleloader build or a complete restoration of a firearm.

Some tools and supplies may be available for purchase at the campus store. If you have financial aid funds available, you may use financial aid for these items, provided the purchases are made through the campus store.

If your program requires a specific laptop, you may also use financial aid to purchase it through the campus store. However, laptops do not need to be purchased through the campus store—you may choose to buy from another retailer. If purchasing a laptop elsewhere, it is the student's responsibility to carefully review the required specifications for their specific program to ensure compatibility.
