DESCRIPTION

This position offers a compensation range of \$47,900 to \$71,900 and involves supporting students through collaboration with public schools and truancy stakeholders. The role includes coordinating student services, evaluating and adjusting case plans, and contributing to program development aligned with its mission and philosophy. The worker gathers and shares professional observations with school and mental health staff, consults with parents and caregivers on behavioral, emotional, and health-related concerns, and develops aftercare and follow-up education plans. Responsibilities also include preparing student records and progress reports, conducting home or agency visits as needed, assisting with community education programs, and providing crisis evaluation and intervention. The position supports truancy reduction efforts by working with principals, schools, OSG, and Family Services, while also offering cultural referrals to strengthen student identity and well-being.

- Proficiency in Ojibwe culture and participation in Anishinaabe teachings (preferred)
